### Sensory



- Easily distracted
- Activity level is usually high  $\checkmark$
- Activity level is usually low
- Difficulty calming self  $\checkmark$
- Under reactive to touch,  $\checkmark$ movement or sound
- Clumsy or uncoordinated  $\checkmark$
- Picky eater  $\checkmark$
- Oral sensitivity  $\checkmark$
- Does not tolerate brushing teeth  $\checkmark$
- Low muscle tone  $\checkmark$
- Walks on toes

Inability to draw simple shapes (square, cross, and X)

Fine motor/visual Es FF, GB,

- Difficulty using 3-finger grasp
- Hard time with dressing skills

    - Legibility of work  $\checkmark$


### Indicators for Speech Therapy

#### Signs of delay

- $\checkmark$  Lisp or stuttering that causes a child embarrassment, frustration, or difficulty with peers
- Not showing an interest in  $\checkmark$ communicating
- ✓ Problems sucking, chewing, or swallowing
- ✓ Excessive drooling
- Problems with control and coordination of lips, tongue, and jaw
- A sudden loss of speech and  $\checkmark$ language skills.

- Signs of delay
- ✓ No word combinations by 24 months
- ✓ Problems understanding your child's speech at 24 months
- ✓ Strangers having problems understanding your child's speech by 36 months of age
- ✓ Difficulty socializing with peers
- ✓ Hard time following multi-step directions
